HOW IS MY BUSINESS IMPACTED?

INCREASED JOB TURNOVER & TRAINING

The average cost of recruiting and training replacement workers consumes **21% of a worker's annual salary.**

POOR EMPLOYEE HEALTH

Substance abuse and addiction jeopardize physical and mental health. Basic health needs are neglected causing increased use of health benefits and sick time, and more absenteeism and tardiness.

DECREASED PRODUCTIVITY

Impaired employees function at around 67% of their working potential.

SAFETY RISKS

The effects of substance abuse can increase accidents and result in more worker's compensation claims: 38% - 50% of claims are due to substance abuse.

LOW EMPLOYEE MORALE

Substance use can strain relationships and negatively affect teamwork, trust, confidence, quality of work, turnover, and positive culture.

INCREASED ABSENTEEISM

Workers with substance use disorder miss nearly 50% more days of work than peers. Workers with opioid use disorder miss nearly 3x as many...

COMPANY IMAGE & COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Employers who don't take steps to support employees with substance use issues, can reflect **negatively on the organization as a whole** and reduce the ability to attract high-quality employees and deter customers.
